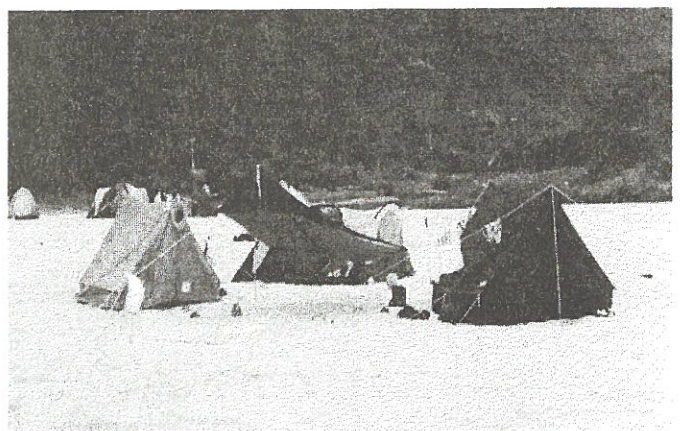
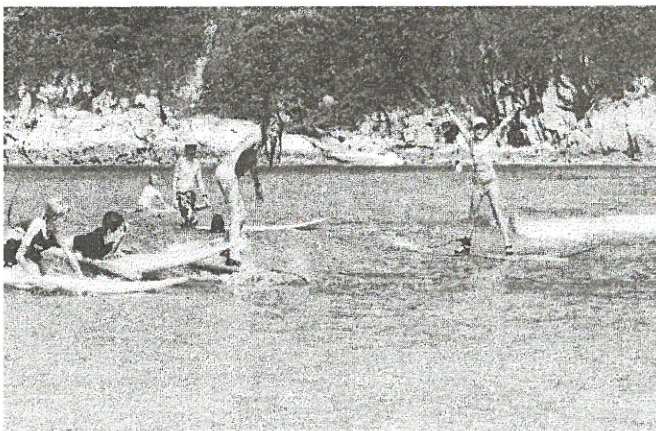
Julie is your friend who lives in Canada. Both she and you love outdoor camping. In her last email, Julie asks you a question:
