Question

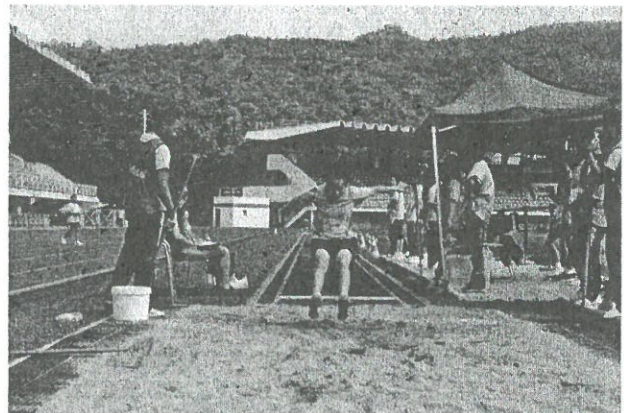
Your friend, Jess, lives in Canada. He/She is the same age as you. Write a letter to tell him/her about your school sports day that you had last week.
